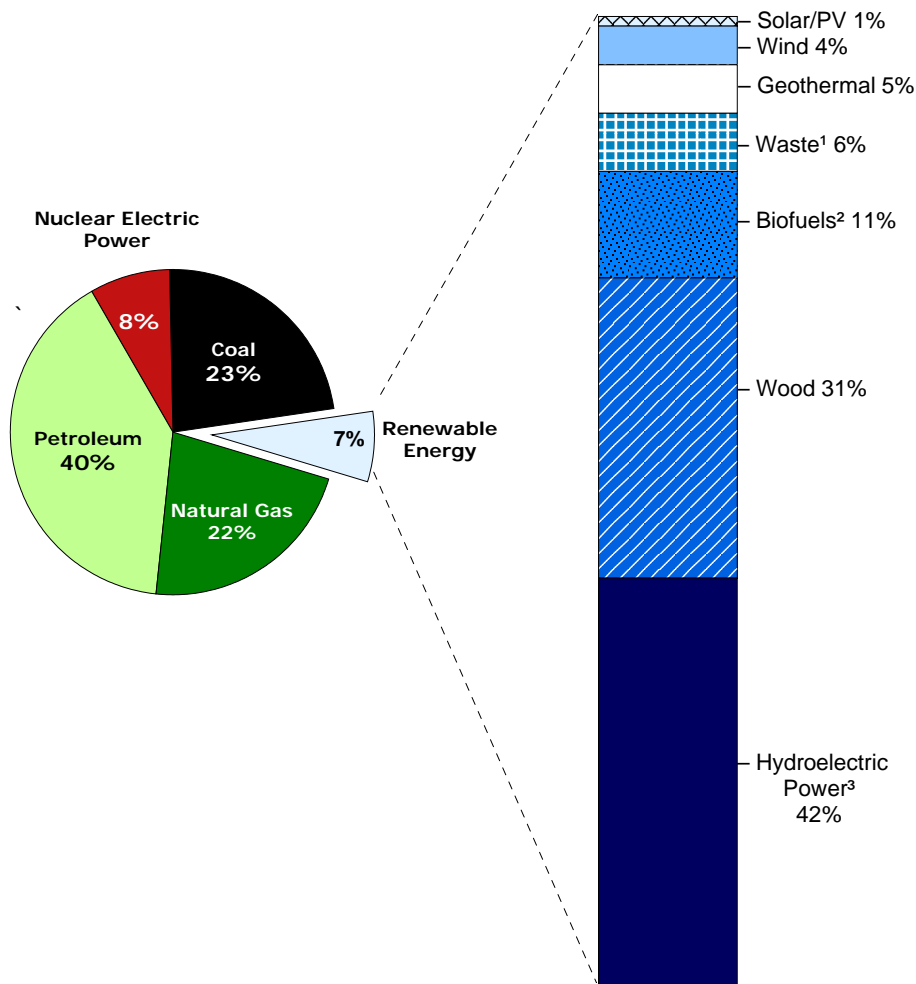
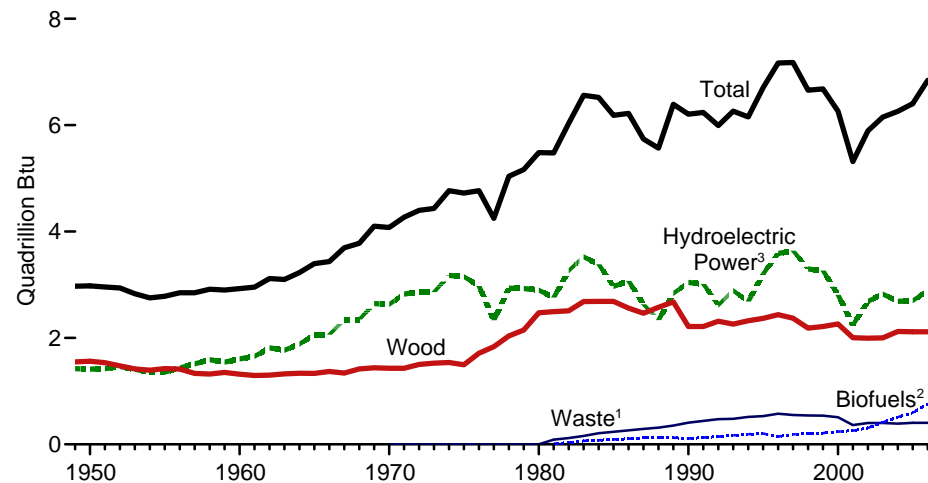


Figure 10.1 Renewable Energy Consumption by Major Sources

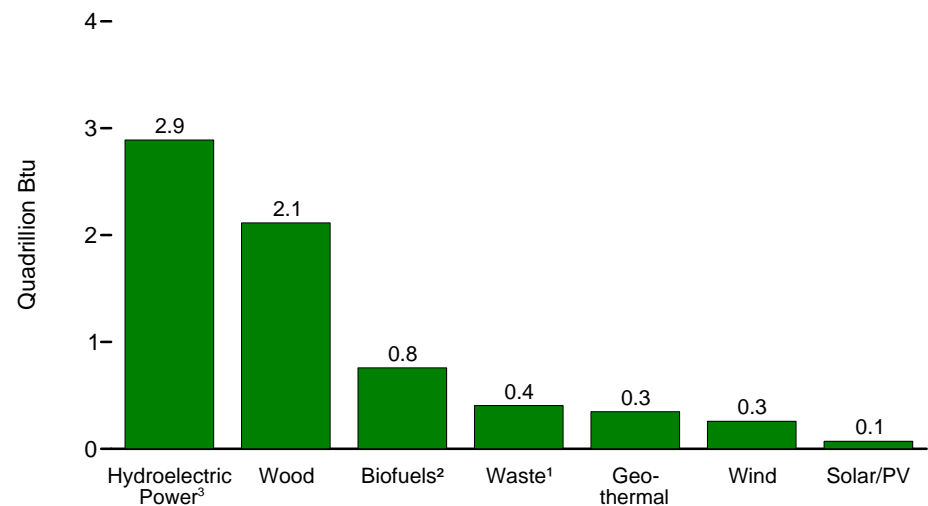
Renewable Energy as Share of Total Energy, 2006
