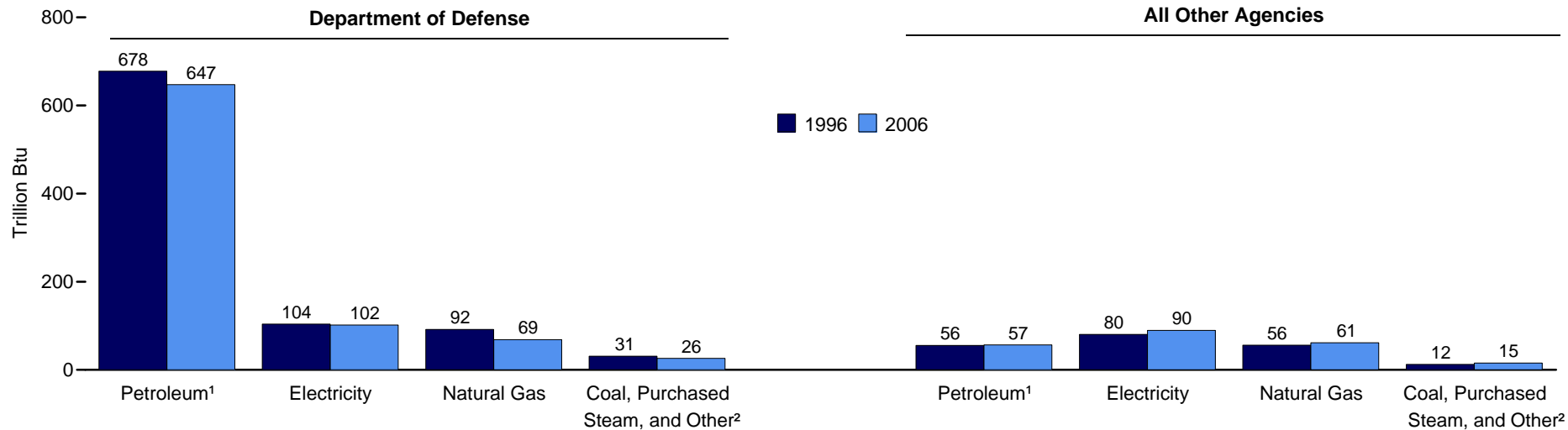
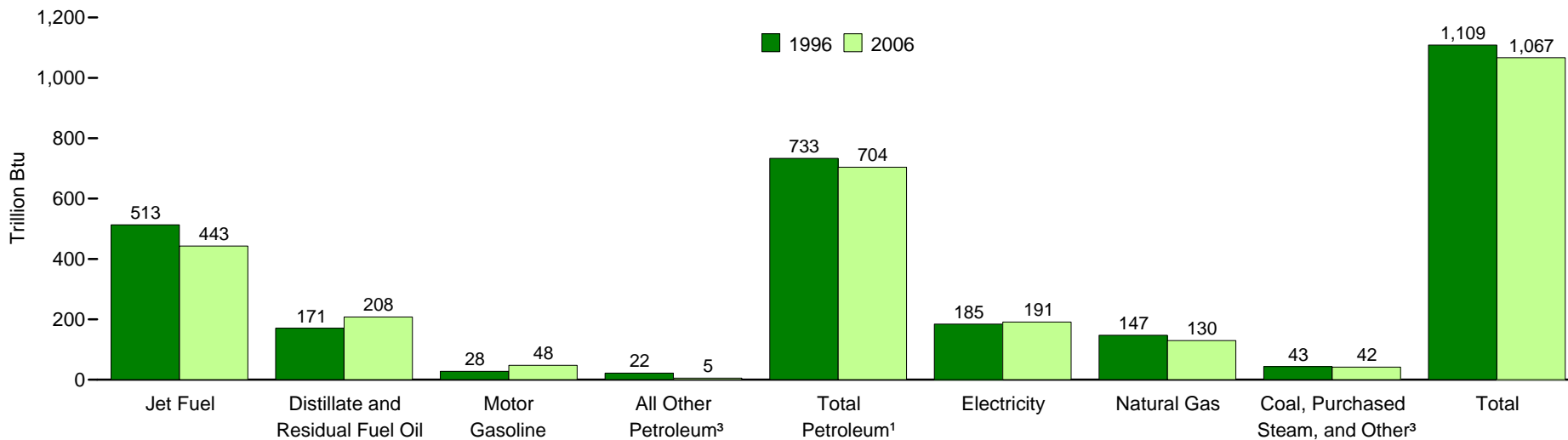


Figure 1.13 U.S. Government Energy Consumption by Agency and Source, Fiscal Years 1996 and 2006
