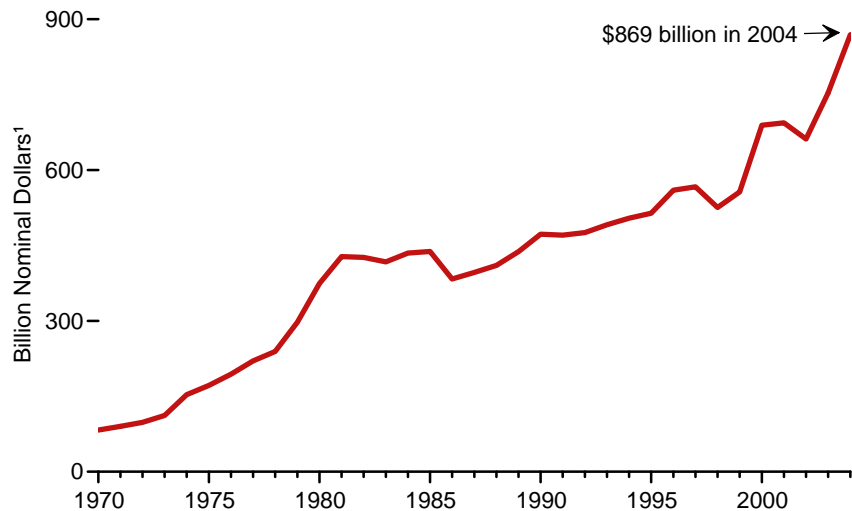
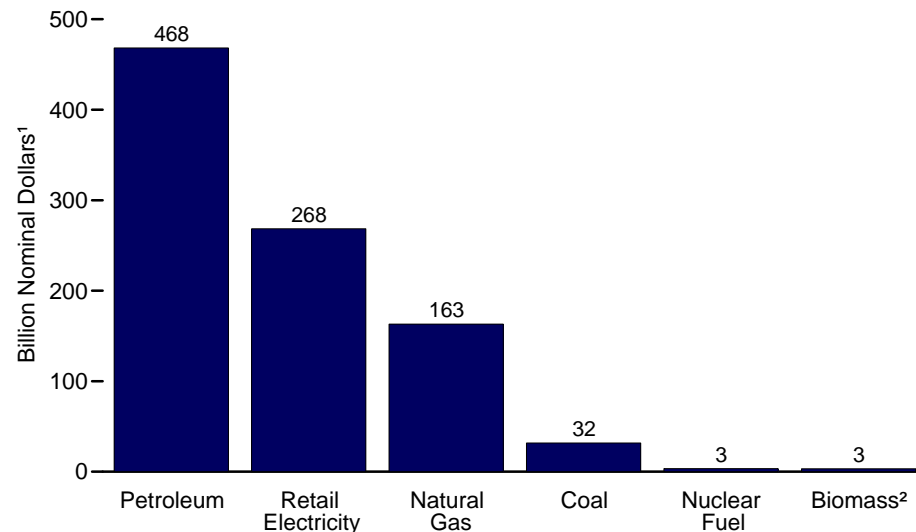


Figure 3.5 Consumer Expenditure Estimates for Energy by Source

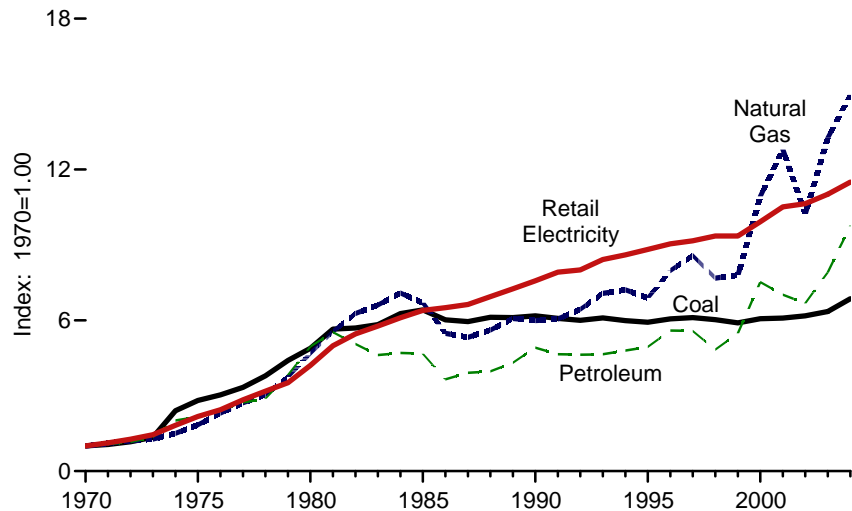
Total Energy, 1970-2004



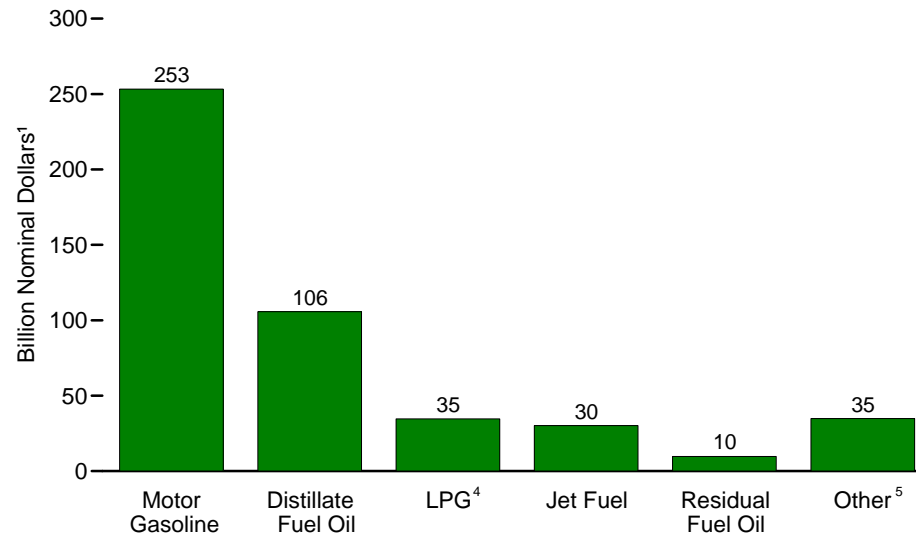
By Energy Type, 2004
