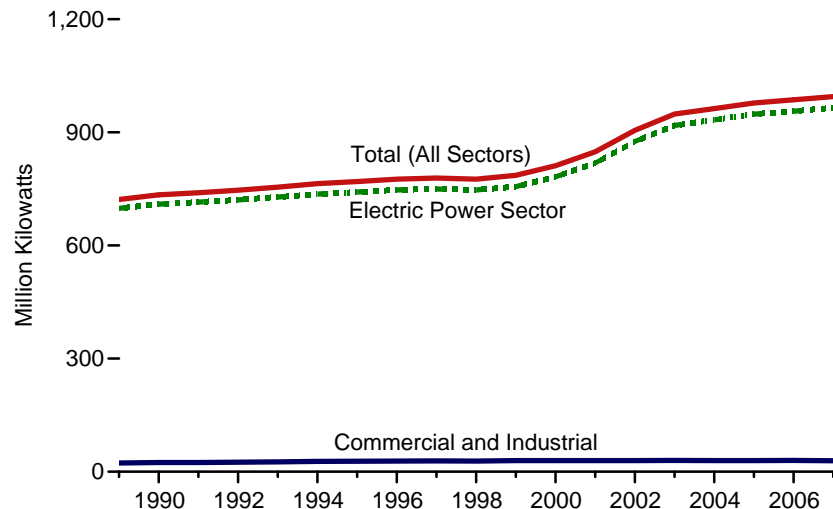
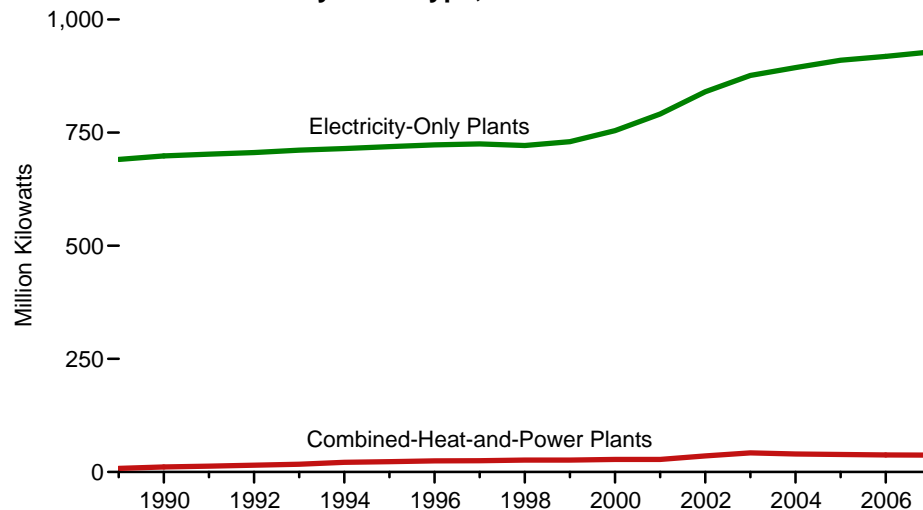


**Figure 8.11b Electric Net Summer Capacity by Sector**

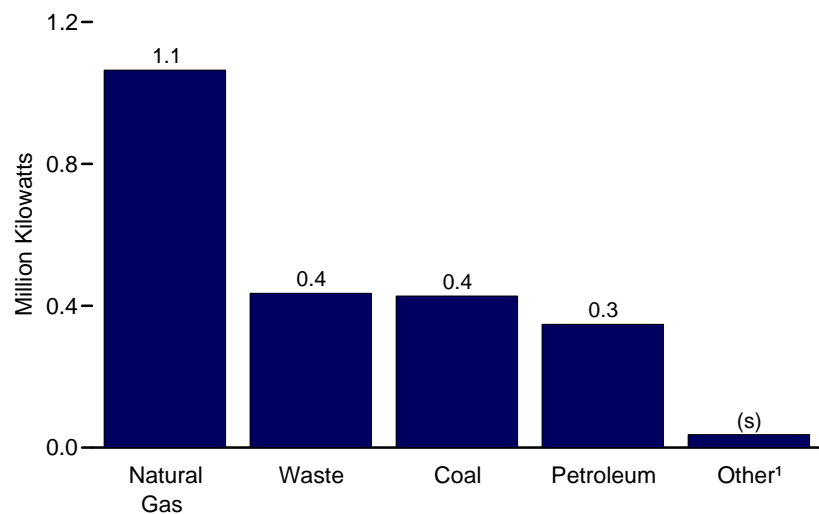
**Total (All Sectors) and Sectors, 1989-2007**



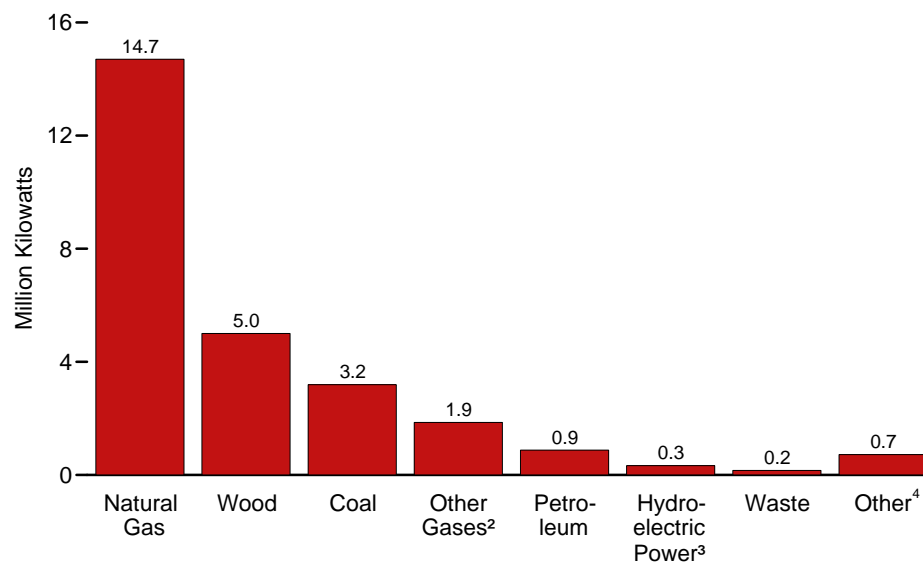
**Electric Power Sector by Plant Type, 1989-2007**
