

Nominal Gross Domestic Product by State

The nominal gross domestic product (GDP) data used in the Energy Information Administration State Energy Data System to calculate total energy consumed per nominal dollar of output are shown in Tables C1 through C4. The data are the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Economic Analysis, nominal GDP estimates by State. The estimates are released June of each year.

For 1970 through 1996, BEA reports nominal GDP by State based on the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC). For 1997 forward, the BEA reports nominal GDP by State based on the 1997 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). Given this discontinuity in the GDP by States series at 1997, users of these data are strongly cautioned against appending the two data series in an attempt to construct a single time series of GDP by State estimates.

The U.S. real GDP is extracted from the same data source as the State data. This sum does not match the national account GDP series. For details, see BEA Regional Economic Accounts: Methodologies, <http://www.bea.gov/regional/methods.cfm>.
