See Glossary for further explanation.⁴ Includes adjustments for fuel ethanol and motor gasoline blending components.⁵ Includes finished petroleum products, unfinished oils, gasoline blending components, and natural gas plant liquids.⁶ Includes an estimate of minor product stock change based on monthly data.⁷ Distillate fuel oil stocks located in the "Northeast Heating Oil Reserve" are not included. For details see Appendix B.⁸ Includes crude oil product supplied, natural gas liquids, liquefied refinery gases (LRGs), other liquids, and all finished petroleum products except motor gasoline, kerosene-type jet fuel, distillate, residual fuel oils, and propane/propylene.⁹ Includes domestic and Customs-cleared foreign crude oil in transit to refineries.¹⁰ Included are stocks of all other oils such as aviation gasoline, kerosene, natural gas liquids and LRGs (except propane/propylene), other hydrocarbons and oxygenates, aviation gasoline blending components, naphtha and other oils for petrochemical feedstock use, special naphthas, lube oils, waxes, coke, asphalt, naphtha-type jet fuel, road oil, and miscellaneous oils.¹¹ Crude oil stocks in the SPR include non-U.S. stocks held under foreign or commercial storage agreements.
